INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

These instructions are provided as a general guideline to cover most applications, and are written for experienced, professional tile installers. Please read these instructions before beginning any work.

- All Domani Tile installations benefit by extended cure times prior to grouting
- Use non-sanded grout or clear silicone as a grouting substance
- Domani Tiles, Table Tops & Vanity Tops are to be installed exclusively indoors

WALLS & BACKSPLASHES

- Domani Tiles have a durable acrylic backing material that may not be compatible with standard tile mastics and adhesives. Therefore, we recommend using a nonsolvent based adhesive, like <u>Bostik</u> <u>70-03A</u>. Please refer to our website for the Bulletin and Material Safety Data pdf.
- 2. Apply the adhesive directly to the back of each tile and apply to a fully cured wall surface. To prevent slippage during installation, you may want to create an 8 point masking tape support assembly which consists of a cross vertically and horizontally with an X across the tape.
- 3. Remove the masking tape after 24 hours and grout accordingly.

GLASS TILE CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Using a Rubi Cutter with a 6mm wheel, score the backside of the tile
- With a sharp utility knife, cut through the backer along the score line
- Turn tile over & GENTLY score the glass with the same wheel & snap
- Once glass & backer are cut, turn tile over (face down) & cut adhesive layer in between the backer and the glass
- Polish the top glass edge along the score line with #100-800 Granite Stone polishing pads at an angle to remove sharp edges
- ALWAYS USE EYE PROTECTION when working with glass tiles
